Their armour was made up of two parts: a corselet (a back and chest plate) and tassets (armour that covered the tops of their legs). The pike that the men carried was approximately 18 feet long and made of a hard wood. The top 4 feet of the pike was wooden with metal around it, with a sharp spiked spearhead at the top. Pikes were very heavy and difficult to carry; only the strongest men could use them properly.
